Chickamauga Lake Preview

Chickamauga Lake is a reservoir created in 1940 when the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) impounded a section of the Tennessee River. Chickamauga is a 36,200-acre reservoir with 810 miles of shoreline, and the lake stretches from Watts Bar Dam to Chickamauga Dam.

Chickamauga offers a variety of habitat types (ex. stumps, laydowns, humps, points, rocky shorelines, aquatic vegetation, etc.) that provide a healthy environment for several species of gamefish. We will target largemouth bass and smallmouth bass very close to the spawn. The current regulation for largemouth bass at Chickamauga is 5 fish/15-inch minimum per day.

The Largemouth bass spawn occurs over several weeks in the spring (March-May) when water temperatures are in the 68-72-degree range. Pay close attention to the water temps and moon phases to find the big ones!
